The final speaker was Laura Sherrod, our wildlife biologist. She spoke on Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD). No cases are in our county and most were detected on deer breeding ranches. Closest cases to our area are in Washington County. She gave a reminder to beware of animals that could have rabies.

Rob Cliff from Camp Kubena gave a talk about what Camp Kubena is about. He mentioned there are summer jobs available

Luke announced that Scott Vinklarek will match dollar for dollar any donations to NCFCWMC that are received by June 1, 2023.

Many door prizes were given to the members. A bucket raffle and a card raffle (gun was prize) were also held.
