STAND COUNTS FOR DEER

Stand counts will be utilized for harvest recommendations on ranches that standard census techniques cannot be used such as on smaller acreages and/or ranches with extremely dense vegetation.

Guidelines for Stand Count

- 1. One stand per one hundred acres of deer habitat.
- 2. A minimum of five settings per stand.
- 3. A minimum of two hour observation per stand setting.
- 4. All stands in an area should have observers at the same time.
- 5. Be careful not to record the same deer twice at the same setting.
- 6. Complete stand settings between August 1 September 15.
